
Citizens Fire Academy 2015



2015 CITIZENS FIRE ACADEMY ITINERARY

March 19

Participants will learn the history and organization of Mooresville Fire-Rescue.



March 26

Participants will review emergency apparatus & equipment and tour the five fire stations.

April 2

Participants will learn about personal protective equipment and self-contained breathing apparatus, including costs and maintenance.

April 9

Participants will learn about emergency medical services and receive CPR instruction and certification.

April 16

Participants will receive training in fire operations including fire attack and aerial operations.

April 23

Participants will learn the roles of the Fire Marshal's office, including fire investigations, inspections and fire extinguisher training.



April 30

Participants will learn special rescue operations and observe high angle demonstrations.

May 7

Participants will observe a vehicle extrication and "jaws of life" demonstration.

May 14

Participants will witness the operations and landing of an EMS medical helicopter and observe a hazardous materials demonstration.



May 21

Participants will review the fitness and education requirements of a firefighter.

All participants will have the opportunity to ride along with the fire companies.
